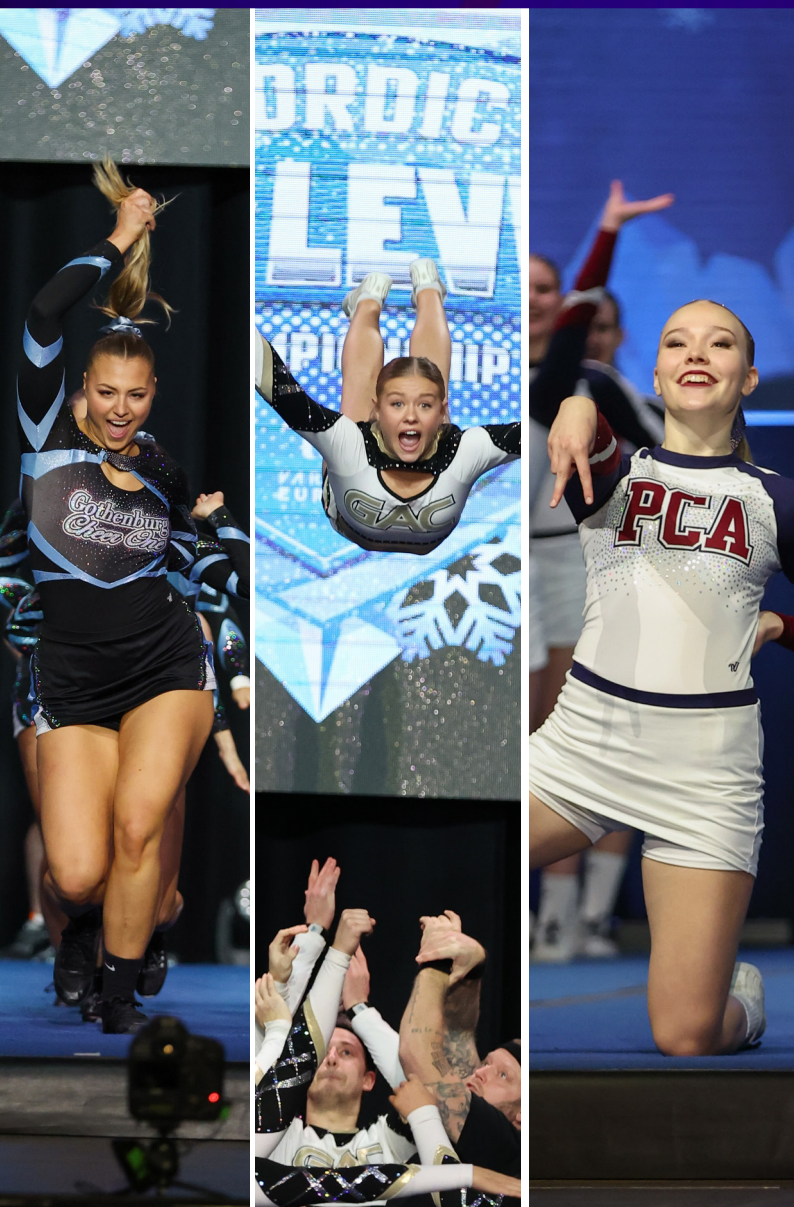

THE SUMMIT 2024

The SUMMIT Championship is one of the most prestigious All Star Championships for Level 1-4. The Summit Cheer Championship is taking place right after Worlds week from May 2nd - 5th, 2024!

Founded by Varsity All Star in 2013 provides a unique experience for athletes in the non-Worlds divisions to compete against the best of the best in all levels of competition across the globe. Our Championships continue to grow, offering multiple paths for Jr & Sr All Star teams to have a competitive, prestigious and celebratory end to their season.

10 AT LARGE BIDS

There are a total of 10 Bids awarded in the U18 Level 3 & 4 & Int. Open Level 4 Bid Divisions as follows:

U18 Level 3, U18 Coed Level 3, U18 Level 4, U18 Coed Level 4, Int. Open Level 4, Int. Open Coed Level 4

An overall ranking will be created from all teams that competed in these divisions. The Bids will be awarded to the highest scoring and eligible teams from the respective overall ranking

2 PAID BIDS

2 out of the 10 at large bids listed above will be upgraded to a paid bid using the following criteria:

The paid bid will be determined by the highest score in the overall section of the scoresheet, should there be more than two teams meeting this requirement the tie-breaker will be the team with the lowest deductions. The third tie-breaker will be the tumbling score if needed.

PAID Bids include accommodation & participation for up to 24 Athletes and 2 coaches for four nights at Disney's All Start Resort.

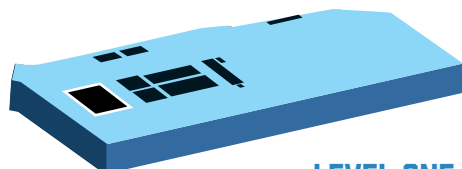

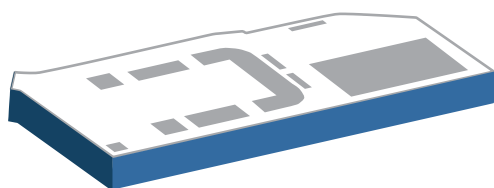
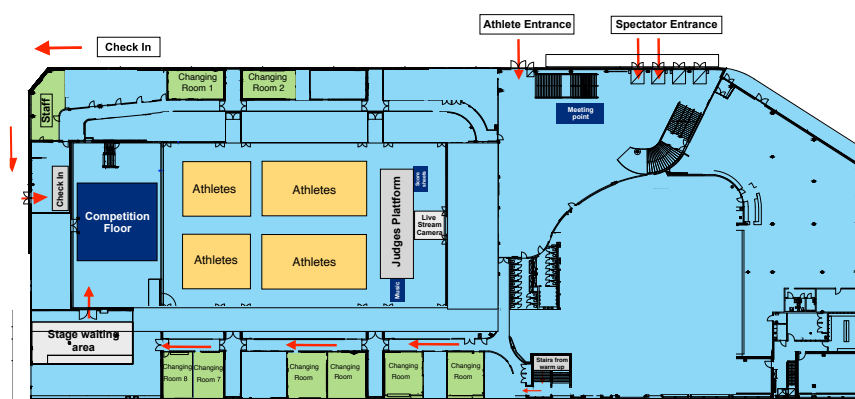
QUICK GUIDE TO PARTILLE ARENA

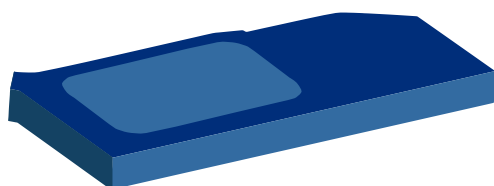
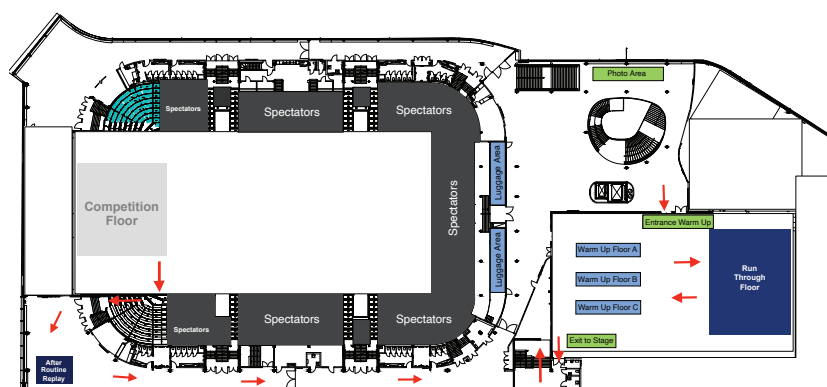
LEVEL ONE:

- Changing Rooms



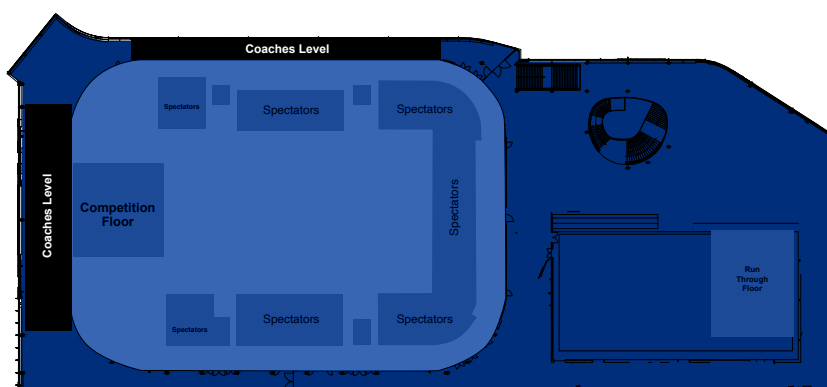
LEVEL TWO:

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT QUESTIONS

How do I register my team?

The registration will only be done online. Please set up an account for your club on booking.varsity-europe.org

Within your account, you can set up all athletes, coaches, assistants, and also create your teams. With only a few more steps, you can then register your teams to the current events.

How to upload the coaches agreement form?

Please follow these steps to upload your forms:

1. Log in to your account on booking.varsity-europe.org
2. Click on the tab named "REGISTRATION" on the upper right
3. Click on "REGISTER" on the very left side
4. Next, choose the competition that you'd like to upload the form for (It's important that you have already registered for that event)
-> See under "My team registrations" the column "FILES"
-> Click on "COACHES"
5. Click on "ADD FILE" and choose the according file from your hard drive.
6. Click on "SAVE". You can always update the form prior to the each event.

Can I send my registration via email or by mail?

Email or Mail-In registration are NOT available.

I want to add an athlete after my registration, what can I do?

Until the according final registration deadline for the event you can easily cancel your registration and apply newly with your changes. Please go to your "registration" area. Then choose "register" and the according championship under "Archives". There you can find the Button "Cancel final registration and apply changes". You can now add another team to the registration. In order to add another person to an existing team, you need to cancel the team by clicking the X. Than you need to add the new person under "team" to your team. After that is all done, you can redo the registration for that team and finalize your registration. Please note that the prices will be based on the date a single person was registered.

After the registration deadline you can only request changes over the "Request Changes" Button under Archives

I would like to register for the early registration fees but I don't have all registration forms together yet, what can I do?

Please register your team online for the early booking rates. You will need to upload the Coaches agreement form - 7 days prior to the event.

TEAM QUESTIONS

In how many divisions can the members of my club participate in?

Each individual can participate in up to three divisions. (please check the cross-over rules).

My coach is also participating in one of my registered teams. How should I register?

Please register them as coaches in the according teams. Be aware - Coaches are always allowed to compete as well.

How many Coaches and Assistants can I register?

Team/divisions can register up to 5 coaches / assistants.

I have to change the name of a participant after the registration deadline. Do I have to pay the changing fee of 15 EUR for that and up to what date can I change names?

For a simple change of names like A to B, we are not invoicing the 15 EUR. Please request the change online. You can request changes up until November 13th 2023.

We noticed that we enrolled in the wrong division. Can we change the division?

A change of division is an enormous workload for Varsity Europe. Therefore, we will have to charge you 200 EUR for this change. Please make sure to enroll in the right division and check before finalizing your registration. The fee will only be applied after the registration deadline.

When can I expect the first draw of the performance order and list of participants.

The performance order as well as the list of participants will be published up to 7 days after the final registration deadline. You will receive an info email about it and it will also be published on our website.

Will there also be Dance divisions at the Nordic All Level Championship?

Yes! You can enroll in Peewee, Junior and Senior Dance Divisions! But we only offer our Marley Dann Floor with 5 or more registered Dance teams.

DEADLINES

Up until when do I need to register my team?

Deadline for registration: 18.09.2023

Up until when can I cancel participants or a team and what are the fees?

Single participants can be cancelled until the final registration deadline of the event and you will receive a credit note of 20% of the registration fees. After the final registration deadline, there are no refunds possible. All changes made after registration deadline will result in a 15 EUR changing fee per person.

Up until when can I register participants and what are the fees?

Additional registrations and changes of individuals whose team has already registered is possible until November 13th, 2023. After this date, changes are only possible at check in. If you need to register someone after the registration deadline it will result in an extra 15 EUR changing fee per person. Change of division will result in a 200 EUR changing fee.

EVENT SHIRTS

How can I order event shirts for the competition?

All orders made up until the general registration deadline (Oktober 2nd) will receive a guaranteed shirt. After that date, the event shirts will be available on site at the event – Only while stocks last!

The following sizes are available:

S / M / L / XL / XXL for adults and YS, YM / YL / YXL for kids.

I have ordered eventshirts for my team and for our fans, where can I pick them up?

Fully paid shirts will be handed out at the cheer shop.

We have ordered eventshirts but have not paid the invoice yet and tomorrow is competition weekend, what can I do?

If your payment has not been received up to the day prior to the competition your shirts will automatically be released. You can now only buy the shirts there at the Cheer Shop.

COMPETITION DAY

Do I have to send in the routine music for my teams?

Each team is required to assign a responsible adult who knows the routine and music to stay with a phone at the music station during the team's performance. This representative is responsible for starting and stopping the music on the phone. Please make sure that the music is downloaded and all devices are fully charged, placed in airplane mode, and the volume is turned up. You can upload your music to our booking portal just in case something went wrong with the music device.

How do I get more detailed infos about the competition?

Details about the competition will be send to you prior to the competition via email and also at the competition check in at the event.

What rulebook is the Nordic All Level Championship based on?

All varsity Europe Competitions follow the United Scoring System for Cheer and the Varsity Allstar Dance Scoring System for Dance Divisions.

Every Routine needs to follow the IASF Rules for Cheer and Dance.

AFTER THE COMPETITION

My team has received a Bid for The SUMMIT 2024.

What am I supposed to do next?

The registration will be processed through Varsity Europe. You will receive a Bid Information Email within 7 Days of the competition. If you have any further questions - please contact events@varsity-europe.org

Please note that your Bid is only valid for 2024.

When and how can I get my routine pictures?

When you check in, you will receive an A4 paper with your personal QR code. If you scan it, you will immediately get to your personal Action Shots. If you can't find the QR after the championship, please send us an email to: svenja.kollek@varsity-europe.org



GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Varsity Brands Europe GmbH is the organizer of the Nordic All Level Championship. The following general terms and conditions apply unconditionally to this event. Additions and alterations require the written approval of all contractual partners.

1. Conclusion of the contract

The complete registration of a participating team and therefore of all of its participating members embodies a binding offer for a contract formation. Acceptance of the offer takes place with the confirmation of participation sent by the Varsity Brands Europe GmbH. A complete registration consists of the filing of the complete registration forms (team registration, team roster, coaches agreement form) and by transferring the complete payment of the balance to the Varsity Brands Europe GmbH.

2. Withdrawal of the participation

The participant can cancel his or her participation and other special offers until 28 days prior to the competition. In this case there will be a cancellation fee of 80% of the initial competition fee and special offers. No fees can be refunded when participants cancels or withdraws from the competition and special offers after 28 days prior to the event.

3. Transfer of the contract

The transfer of all demands of the participant in the cause of the event no matter on which legal grounds is foreclosed. The legal enforcement of assigned demands is foreclosed.

4. Change of services

The event organizer reserves the right to change particular legally agreed goods and services when it becomes necessary and if those do not change the overall aim of the championship. Changes on the date and the schedule shall remain reserved.

5. Services not used

If a participant does not make use of a service offered he or she has no right of refund regarding this service.

6. Changes after registration deadline

All changes made after the registration deadline will result in a 15 EUR processing fee per person. Change of category will result in a 200 EUR changing fee.

7. Warranty rights and statute of limitations

The organizer is liable for the proper execution of the championship under the German law. If any services are deficient the participant has to state this immediately to the organizer. Claims expire by limitation of one year. The year begins the day of the last day of championship.

8. Exclusion of liability and code of conduct

The organizer does not assume any liability for lost belongings, accidents or personal or property damage. The organizer does not assume any liability for disturbances or deficiencies of services of third persons. The rules of the house apply. The personal identification card of the championship has to be carried along at

any time of the championship, is not transferable and will not be replaced when lost. No alcohol is to be consumed during the entire competition and any related events. Violation of this rule can result in exclusion of the participant without entitlement to refunds of any fees. The participants have to be on time and warmed up at particular competition points and have to follow the directions and instructions of the organizers and their staff. Otherwise the rulebook of the championship applies. Taking professional photos or videos during the championship is forbidden. Violation of this rule can result in exclusion of the participant without entitlement to refunds of any fees. All documents and information of the championship are exclusively for participants of this contract. Participants become liable to damages when submitting the documents or information to third persons.

9. Requirements for participants

The participant is strictly responsible for fulfilling all requirements asked for to participate at the championship and has to make sure that he or she meets all medical requirements and has the ability to compete at the championship. In case of uncertainty regarding a participants medical and health conditions, the participants has to discuss the issue immediately with the Varsity Brands Europe GmbH. Every participant must assure that he or she has a valid accident and health insurance.

10. Data protection

All information, photos and videos of participating people gathered in the course of the championship can be passed on to third persons or might be published by the event organizer without any claim of refund in regard to the participant. The participant agrees that all his or her personal information necessary for the execution of the championship is recorded by the organizer in electronic form or in writing.

11. Invalidness of single appointments

If a single term of this terms and conditions becomes invalid all other terms do not lose the validity.
