

## Varsity Europe Fan/Spectator Code of Conduct:

Varsity Europe makes every effort to provide all athletes, coaches and spectators with a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience when participating in our events.

When attending an event organized by Varsity Europe, you are expected to follow our Fan Code of Conduct. The Code of Conduct addresses behavior that endangers the safety of others or interferes with the enjoyment of our events or promotes a positive environment for all.

The following behavior is prohibited at all Varsity Europe events and will result in exclusion from the event and/or possible exclusion from future Varsity Europe events:

- Disruptive, aggressive, assaultive, threatening or violent behavior including verbal or physical harassment of officials, participants, staff, judges or fans
- Foul or abusive language and obscene gestures
- Intoxication or other signs of alcohol or substance impairment that results in irresponsible behavior
- Cameras with extended lenses (telephoto zoom beyond 70 mm, etc.) are prohibited
- Failure to follow the instructions of Varsity Europe staff or venue security personnel

In general, it is forbidden to bring food and drinks. Filming and professional photography is not permitted, especially in the competition hall. Varsity Europe assumes no liability for accidents, lost items, theft or other damages of any kind. The general house rules of the event hall as well as the general terms and conditions of Varsity Europe apply. The carrying and use of confetti cannons or other fan utensils, the use of which requires a separate cleaning of the venue, is prohibited on the entire premises of the event hall. Depending on the development of a possible medical pandemic situation, Varsity Europe reserves the right to issue special admission regulations and to restrict access to the event based on the regulations.
